The Parallels of Faith Promise Giving

2 Corinthians 8:6-9

While there are various methods in how churches can be involved with missions, Faith Promise giving is based on the premise that God will independently finance and bless His plan of world evangelization (2 Corinthians 9:8) through the local church.

In our final preparatory message for our up-coming missions conference, we learn of several parallels between the early New Testament church’s approach to missions and Faith Promise missions.
