


Upcoming Events...

## **Knowing Jesus' Simplicity Part 2– Approaching God**

2 Corinthians 11:3— But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

This morning we continue our series based upon Paul's concern for the Corinthians, that Satan had corrupted their minds from the simplicity that is in Christ..

One of the areas that Satan has attacked is man's approachability towards God. The Bible teaches that our sin separates us from God and Satan would have us to think that without religion God is not approachable.

However, the simplicity that is in Christ is that Jesus gives to us a simple and everlasting way to approach God. This morning we'll discover three vital considerations in approaching God through Christ...
